Spring and summer are generally the times when homeowners take a good hard look at the exterior of their house. Often they don't like what they see, as the winter weather may have finally made it imperative to repair damage that's been slowly occurring over the years.

Rendering is often a good solution for stone, brick, cement sheet and previously bagged houses, but the homeowner may just disappear right back inside when they receive quotes for thousands of dollars.

A DIY solution that could cost only a quarter of the price is Rendertex, from Haymes Paint.

It is very easy for home handy people to use, because the product can be mixed in small batches and applied so as to achieve a smooth, trowelled or roller-peak finish. It's just a matter of adjusting the amount of water in your mix and experimenting with trowels and rollers to get the desired effect on some test patches of wall.

Once you've decided on the effect you want, you patch and prime the existing surface. The textured finish goes on next, then the Renderproof Membrane Coating that can be tinted to your desired colour.

Here's a few DIY tips:

1. It's easier to apply the patch if you mix water and cement until it's like mashed potato.
2. For a super smooth finish, trowel on the patch and finish with a wet paintbrush.
3. A rubber foam trowel makes the job much easier than a metal implement.
4. Use a long nap sheepskin roller for best coverage when applying the prime.
